Faye Mishna, Ph.D. is dean and professor at the Factor-Inwentash Faculty of Social Work, University of Toronto and is cross-appointed to the Department of Psychiatry. In addition, she holds the McCain Family Chair in Child and Family. Mishna has worked in children’s mental health for over 20 years and was clinical director of a children’s agency serving children with learning disabilities. She continues to maintain a small private practice in psychotherapy and consultation.

This presentation will facilitate an understanding of how ubiquitous and significant cyber interactions are for children and youth. Material presented will include both the benefits and risks of the cyberworld for children and youth, with the goal of participants gaining a better understanding of cyberbullying and its impact (e.g., definition, similarities and differences from traditional bullying, prevalence), as well as getting further insight into the controversies of this current topic which has gleaned national and internal attention.
