Attention MSW students completing degree requirements Winter term 2010: An e-mail was sent out with an attached graduation memo and audit form. Graduating MSW students will need to fill out the audit form after identifying their course selections for Winter Term 2010 and return it to Julie Alter-Kay (drop off rm. 105 Thompson Home, mail or fax – **no e-mail return**). **Once reviewed and approved, your audit will be mailed to your home address.**

Please remember that you must apply for graduation. While the deadline is **February 5, 2010** for students graduating **May 2010**, we advise students to file for degree during the priority registration period. Applications for graduation must be filed through pipeline under 'Student Record - apply for degree' with a fee of \$40.00. **Please make certain you file for degree for the correct term. If you are completing degree requirements in May 2010, the term is Winter term 2010.** You must apply and pay again if you do not meet requirements in the term of application. You will not graduate if you do not apply!!
