Filing for degree is done by completing your WSU degree Applications for graduation through pipeline under 'Student Record - apply for degree' with a fee of \$40.00. Please make certain you file for degree for the correct term. If you have not yet done so, please make sure you have met with your Academic Advisor to review your plan of work to ensure you are meeting all degree requirements. You must apply and pay again if you do not meet requirements in the term of application.
