<b>Shawn A. Abraham Memorial Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full or part-time undergraduate or graduate student	Recipient must be Detroit resident with leadership skills, financial need and have a minimum 2.50 GPA. Scholarship may be used for tuition or educational expenses.
<b>Art Antisdell Memorial Scholarship</b>	Full-time or part-time graduate students	Preference given to applicants who demonstrate financial need.
<b>Carol Barron Memorial Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full-time or part-time graduate student in second year status	Recipient must provide a 500 word essay on their interest in the area of Social Work with Families, Children, and Youth. They must have a minimum GPA of 3.2.
<b>Virginia Baumgartner King Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate students	Recipient must be a student of good standing in the School of Social Work Program
<b>Elizabeth N. Brehler Endowed Scholar's Program</b>	Currently enrolled undergraduate and graduate student	Manuscript competition. Student submit a 7-10 page paper on social work values & practice to be judged by a panel of faculty & students. One award granted annually during the Winter term. Deadline early February.
<b>Arnette Burwell Memorial Endowed Scholarship</b>	Undergraduate or graduate student	Preference to students from urban economically and/or academically disadvantaged backgrounds. Award is based on financial need and scholastic achievement.
<b>Emmie S. Chestang Memorial Endowed Scholarship</b>	Graduate student	Recipient must have a minimum 3.5 GPA and demonstrate commitment to working with diverse populations.
<b>Rachel I. Coleman Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full or part-time graduate student	Established by <b>Rachel Inez Coleman</b> , who earned her BSW and MSW while undergoing numerous radiation and chemotherapy treatment. She personally established this scholarship to exemplify her strong commitment to the field of social work and future social workers (especially women). This fund, for full- and part-time graduate students, now serves as a memorial tribute to Rachel.
<b>Dean's Scholars Program</b>	Graduate student	Outstanding academic achievement. Students will be evaluated on the basis of a two page statement on their commitment and willingness to assist the Dean in the recruitment and retention of students from economically and academically disadvantaged communities.

<b>Patricia L. Dillick Memorial Scholarship</b>	Full-time graduate student	Awards are made primarily on the basis of academic qualifications to students who are in need of financial aid and show promise of capacity to practice in the field of health care. Essay required.
<b>Cecille Y. Dumbrigue and Shirley P. Thrasher Endowed Memorial Scholarship</b>	Full-time graduate and undergraduate student	Recipients will be full-time graduate or undergraduate students selected on the basis of scholastic achievement and a history of service to vulnerable populations.
<b>Annette Sniderman Freedman Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full-time second year graduate student	Awarded to full time second year graduate students on the basis of scholastic achievement and history of effort to return to school after an interruption in education.
<b>Emmesia Mathews Frost and Kenneth M. Frost Endowed Scholarship Fund</b>	Full or part-time, graduate or undergraduate students	Recipient will be selected demonstrating financial need.
<b>Allan and Harriett Gelfond Endowed Scholarship</b>	Part-time undergraduate or graduate students	Recipient must demonstrate a strong interest in assisting those with developmental disabilities and their families.
<b>Fred and Freda Gentsch Scholarship</b>	Full-time undergraduate or graduate student	Recipient will be selected on the basis of scholastic achievement, character, leadership and need.
<b>Annie L. Pitts Handy Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full-time graduate or undergraduate student	Preference to students raised in an urban environment with demonstrated financial need.
<b>Joseph P. Hourihan Endowed Scholars Award</b>	Full-time graduate student	Recipient will be selected on the basis of professional interest and a goal for working in school social work in inner city schools.
<b>Shirley Doris Hupert Memorial Scholarship</b>	Full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate Student	Recipient must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
<b>Evangeline S. Hyett Endowed Scholarship Fund</b>	Full-time or part-time graduate student	Awarded to students enrolled in the Master of Social Work program demonstrating scholastic achievement and need.
<b>Rose Kaplan Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full-time or part-time graduate student	Recipient is a MSW student placed in an urban environment Field Study Program whose clients consist of indigent persons and/or children.
<b>Vernon Edward Keye Memorial Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full or part-time graduate student	Graduate students with an interest in mental health and the school's Interpersonal Practice concentration.
<b>Alice Lamont Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full or part-time, graduate or undergraduate student	Recipient must have at least a 2.5 GPA at time of selection.
<b>James W. Leigh Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full or part-time graduate students	Recipient must plan to work in Interpersonal Practice and have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
<b>Elizabeth and Reginald MacArthur Tribute Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full or part-time graduate student	Recipient students enrolled in School's MSW program.
<b>Eileen M. Maceroni Memorial Endowed Scholarship</b>	Full or part-time, graduate or undergraduate students	For students with financial need returning to school after interruptions in studies due to child-rearing or other related family circumstances.

**Edward J. Overstreet Endowed Scholarship**

Full-time or part-time graduate student

Preference given to student concentrating in Community Practice and Social Action with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Full-time or part-time graduate student

Recipient with demonstrated leadership qualities, scholastic achievement and community service, with financial need.

**Donald J. Roberts Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

Full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate student

Preference given to student concentrating in Community Practice and Social Action with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

**Harold & Carolyn Robison Memorial Scholarship**

Full-time graduate student

Recipient will be selected on the basis of scholastic achievement, character, leadership, and financial need.

**School of Social Work Alumni Association Endowed Scholarship**

Full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate student

Selection based on participation in activities that promote social work principles; financial need and scholastic achievement.

**School of Social Work Scholarship**

Full-time or part-time graduate or undergraduate

Recipient will be selected on the basis of scholastic achievement, character, leadership, and financial need.

**School of Social Work Futures Endowment Fund**

Full-time and part-time graduate or undergraduate student

Provides financial support to undergraduate or graduate students enrolled in the School of Social Work.

**Raymond Snowden Ph.D, Endowed Memorial Scholarship**

Full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate students

Recipient must demonstrate financial need and maintain a 3.0 GPA.

**Mavis M. Spencer Endowed Scholars Fund**

**Graduate students enrolled in the doctoral social work program.**

**Awards may be used for educational expenses related to conference travel and/or conference registration by doctoral students.**

**Maldo Ellen Talick Endowed Memorial Scholarship**

Full-time graduate or undergraduate student

Recipient must be in good standing with the School (3.0 GPA or above) and have demonstrated need of financial assistance and a commitment to serving underserved urban communities.

**Mary Turner Scholarship Fund**

Full-time graduate and undergraduate student

For social work students with outstanding academic achievement, character, leadership, and financial need.

**Elizabeth Laverack White Scholarship Fund**

Full-Time and part-time undergraduate or graduate students

Recipient must demonstrate scholastic achievement and commitment to social work practice and community service.

**Beryl Zlatkin Winkelman Endowed Scholarship**

Full-time graduate student

Recipient will be selected on the basis of scholastic aptitude and financial need.

**Ella Zwerdling Memorial Scholarship**

Graduate student writing a thesis

The factors that are considered in evaluating the applicants include those required for approval of all theses; namely originality, adequacy, accuracy, significance, methodology, justification of conclusions and correctness of style.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. To be considered for any need-based scholarship(s) you must file the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**. Website address is (<http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>).
  2. **Submit the School of Social Work Private Scholarship application** according to the deadlines listed on the back of form. Only complete applications will be considered for SSW financial aid and/or scholarships. All applications must include a complete **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**, Canadian students must submit an **Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP)**, foreign students submit confirmation of financial support, supporting tax documentattion and proof of all income earned. Earned income includes income earned through employment, income presented as gifts, and income from a spouse, if applicable. **Incomplete, missing or inaccurate information** will result in disqualification of an application for SSW financial aid and/or scholarships. Attach a copy of your individual and spouse W-2 forms and all other proof of income such as 1099 form, Supplemental Income Confirmation, etc.
  3. **Note:** BSW students **must have completed all university general education requirements** to apply for the School of Social Work based scholarship awards.
  4. **Your receipt of any award is contingent upon your agreement** that the School will inform the donor of the scholarship, of your name and selected general information regarding your qualifications for this award. You will be asked to write a note to the donor and attend events (**specifically the Annual Scholarship Reception**) honoring donors and recipients. **Failure to do so will result in the rescinding of the scholarship award.**
