2014 Alumna of the Year: Larmender A. Davis, LMSW, OSW-C

Ms. Davis graduated from Wayne State University with her MSW in 1994 and has gone on to study for a Doctorate in Organization Psychology at WSU. Ms. Davis is a MI licensed social worker who joined the Alumni Association Board in 2009 and is currently the supervisor of the Social Work Department at Karmanos Cancer Institute in Detroit, MI. She is also an agency founder, incorporator, and board member of Serenity Services, a non-profit domestic/sexual violence agency. Born and raised in Detroit, Ms. Davis displays her dedication to the field of social work through her mentorship of social work students and continued pursuit of higher education, all while working tirelessly with community partners to improve the city and lives of fellow Detroit natives.

2014 Citizen of the Year: Reverend Dr. Wendell Anthony

Rev. Anthony graduated from Wayne State University with a BA in Political Science, and Marygrove College with an MA in Pastoral Ministry. He also attended the University of Detroit for Advanced Study in Black Theology. Rev. Anthony is a MI certified Social Worker and currently serves as the Senior Pastor of Fellowship Chapel. Rev. Anthony has been instrumental in the cultivation of community outreach organizations in Detroit addressing adult education, homeless assistance, and youth mentorship programs just to name a few. Rev. Anthony has continued to display his focus on community engagement through the founding of the Freedom Institute, a non-profit urban think tank. Rev. Anthony is being honored for his extensive efforts to assist and advance the lives of vulnerable populations within the city of Detroit.
