## CLINICIAN

Experience Camps is a national, no-cost program for grieving children who have experienced the death of a parent, sibling or primary caregiver. Our one-week, overnight summer camp programs help to reframe the experience of grief and empower kids to develop invaluable coping skills that enable them to move forward with their lives.

Clinicians at Experience Camp are a part of a team of masters level mental health professionals who report to the Clinical Director (CD) at that specific location. Under the direction of the CD, clinicians are responsible for facilitating bereavement activities and sharing circles, encouraging grief/bereavement related bunk discussions, practicing behavioral interventions, and providing mental health support to bunk counselors and volunteer staff.

As a camp clinician, your job is to support your campers throughout the week of camp. As a clinician, your responsibilities will be:

- ✓ Facilitate bereavement activities
- ✓ Support and guide camp volunteers
- ✓ Care for camper's well-being
- ✓ Participate in daily clinical meetings
- ✓ Be an active listener
- ✓ Be fully present
- ✓ Bring your unique you
- ✓ Be #FTK (FOR THE KIDS!)
