Acceptable Training Providers

Training offered by a nationally-recognized or state-recognized health-related organization

Training offered by, or in conjunction with, a state or federal agency

Training provided in an educational program that has been approved by licensure board or by the college/university

Reading an article on human trafficking that has been published in a peer reviewed journal

When Does this Apply?

Requirement must be met within your next renewal cycle!

For LMSW/LBSW renewing in 2017:
Deadline = 2020

For LLMSW/LLBSW renewing in 2017:
Deadline = April 30, 2018
