Essential Functions:

An employee in this classification is required to perform some or all of the following duties, however these do not include all of the tasks which the employee may be expected to perform: conducts assessments and makes diagnostic evaluation; provide treatment services delineated within the Individual Plan of Service; participates in the Person Centered Planning process and follows through with plan; provides individual and/or group therapy and crisis intervention as needed; provides education on issues of mental health to service recipients, families, and other staff; may provide direct case management services to service recipients (coordination, linking and monitoring of services) and coordinates activities with other agencies and assists utilization of these resources by service recipients; maintains regular required documentation; maintain confidentiality.

Applicants that meet the Authority's initial screening may be subject to a pre-interview test lasting up to two (2) hours.

Any offer of employment is contingent upon a Criminal Background Check, as well as a 5 Panel Drug Screen. Potential candidates will be sent to Industrial Health Service for a screening at their own expense (\$28). When results are negative for the drug screen, the candidate will then be reimbursed the cost of the screening.

Mobile Crisis Team

- Performs community outreaches for the purpose of intervening in crises when contacted by individuals, schools, law enforcement, etc. Consults with stakeholders in the community as needed.
- -Engages with persons in crisis to facilitate interventions by utilizing Motivational Interviewing techniques.
- -Evaluates persons in crisis for safety and medical needs, and works as a team to assist them to maintain safety and access medical treatment as needed.
- -Links to and engages natural supports, community agencies, and homeless resources to help alleviate crises, and assists individuals in accessing treatment as needed.
- -Transports individuals as needed.
- -Participates in trainings in order to gain skills in crisis intervention, suicide risk assessment, and Recovery.
- -Participates in training and advocacy in the community to promote use of the Mobile Crisis team
- -As needed, performs pre-admission screenings at McClaren hospital and authorizes or denies admission as per medical necessity criteria.
