Title of Position: Peer Mentor/Student Assistant Position

Overview:

The Student Sharing Success Learning Community (S3LC) is seeking bright, energetic self-starter to be the 2016-2017 Peer Mentor. The S3LC Peer Mentor will act as a resource for motivation, empowerment, and support. The ideal applicant for this position should demonstrate successful use of academic and learning strategies, time management, communication, and self-advocacy skills with faculty and resources. Applicants that wish to be considered for this position must be willing to commit to 10 hours a week, and be able to attend the Mentor Training Event in August.

Qualifications:

- Applicants must have at least a sophomore class standing at Wayne State by Fall 2016.
- Minimum grade point average of 3.0.
- Must be able to attend Peer Mentor trainings.
- Strong interpersonal skills, good listening skills, and an ability to work well with others.
- Exemplify an understanding of different learning strategies, disabilities, and cultural backgrounds.
- Preferred applicants for this position are those with the major study in the human services field (education, allied health professions, social work, psychology, public policy, etc.)

Job Description:

- Mandatory attendance at the Mentor Training Event in August and monthly professional development events throughout the year.
- Establish and maintain communication with students using email, or other means.
- Demonstration of effective strategies for academic success.
- Support skills of self-awareness, goals setting and monitoring.
- Attend and assist with the facilitation of two S3LC meetings a month.
- Other duties as assigned.
