In the United States there have been more than a half-million deaths in the past decade, with opioids associated with over two-thirds of these deaths, and the age adjusted overdose death rate in Michigan is almost twice the national average. The Center for Behavioral Health and Justice (CBHJ) has developed two new CE courses to increase awareness and empower change in our Michigan community. These courses will provide information on the overdose epidemic, opioid overdose, administration of naloxone, common types of pain, pain assessment, strategies in pain management and more.
