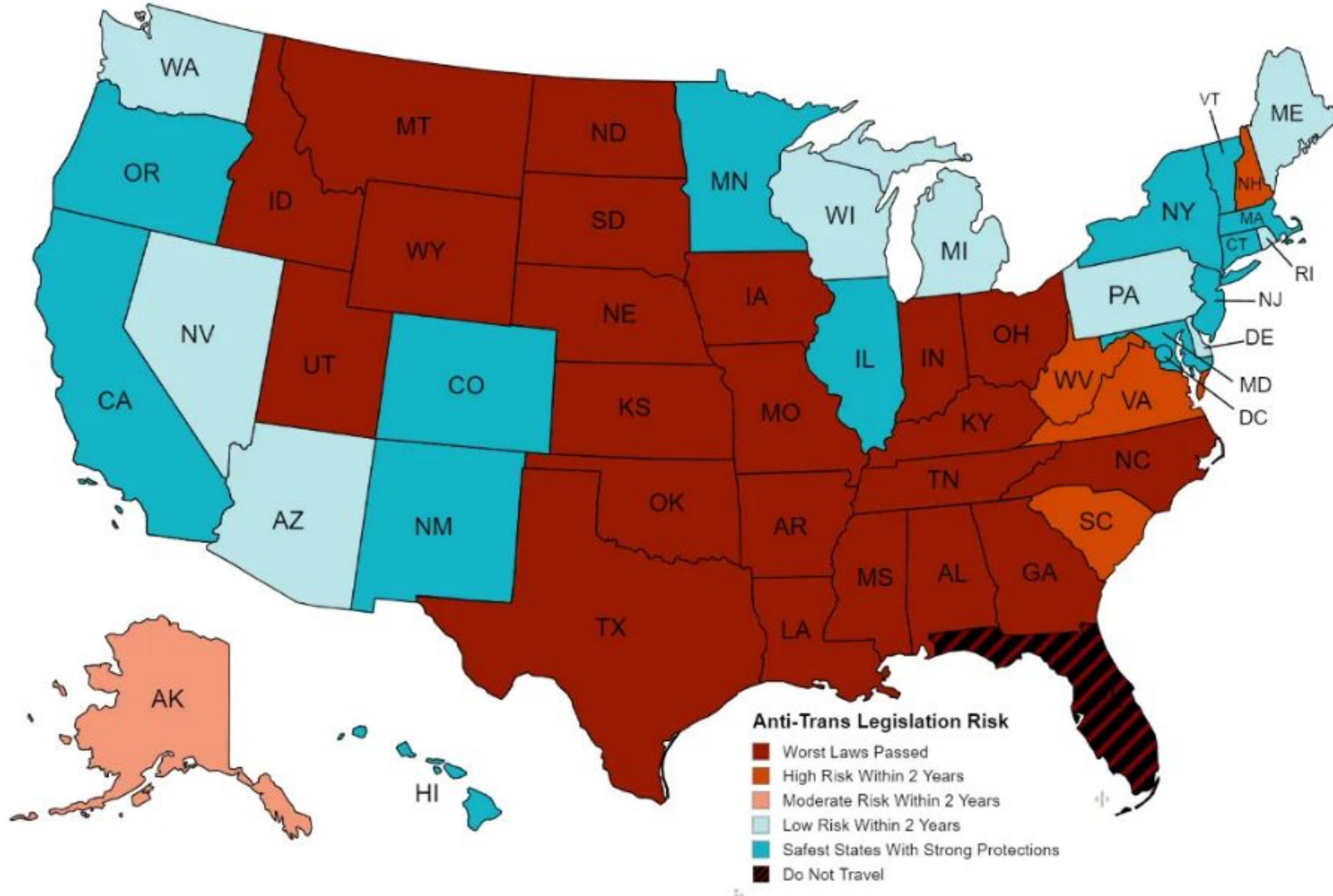

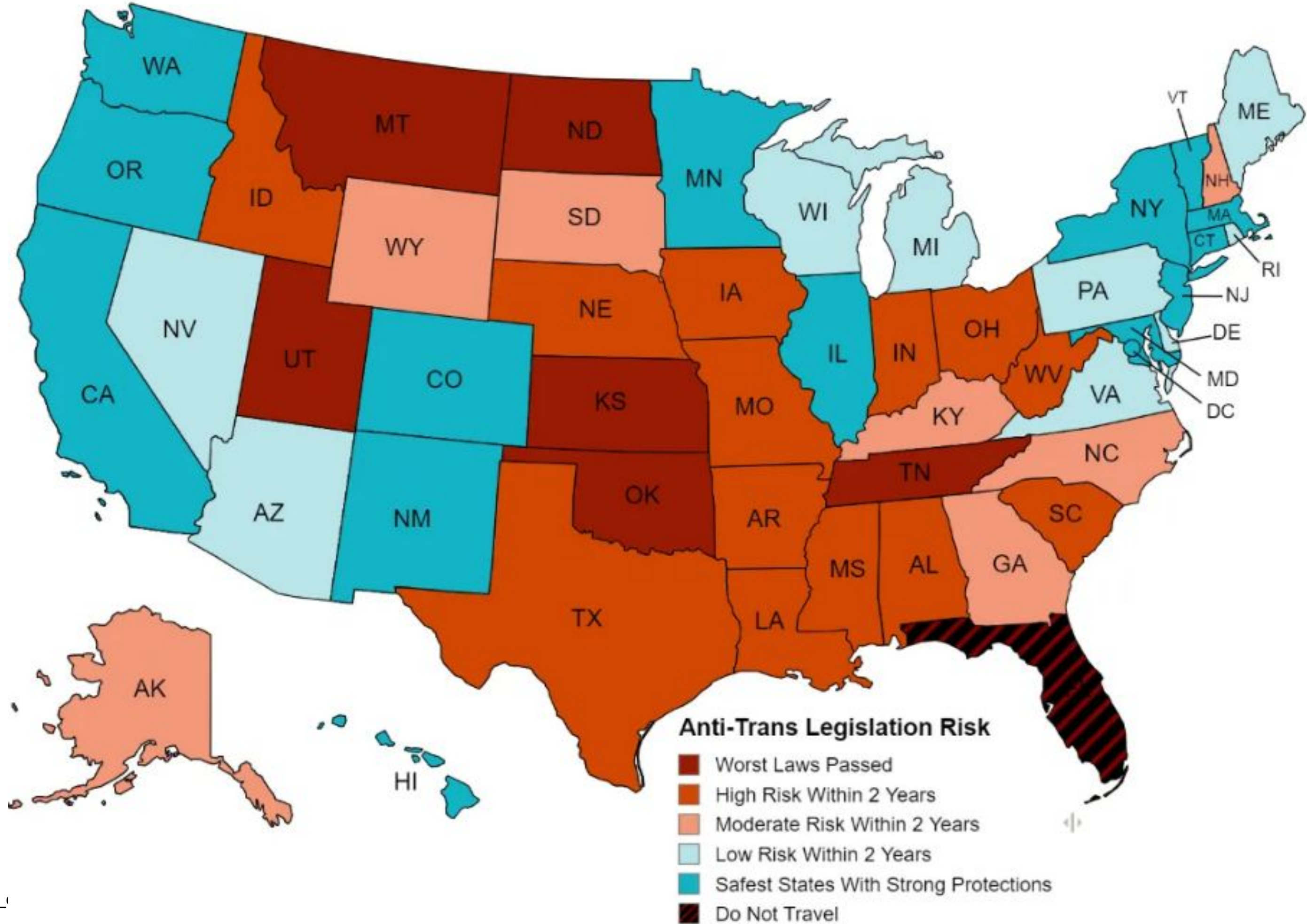

Affirming Care As A Model of Care



Healthcare pathologizes bodies and identities.

Gender-affirming healthcare is based on informed consent, it is trauma-informed, and allows for a life of wellness.

Gender-affirming healthcare puts the patient in the driver's seat.

Care for gender-diverse individuals can be a model for all healthcare.

Trust Underpins Good Healthcare

Trust

50-70% of all trans or gender-diverse patients are discriminated against, large-scale mistrust in medical community

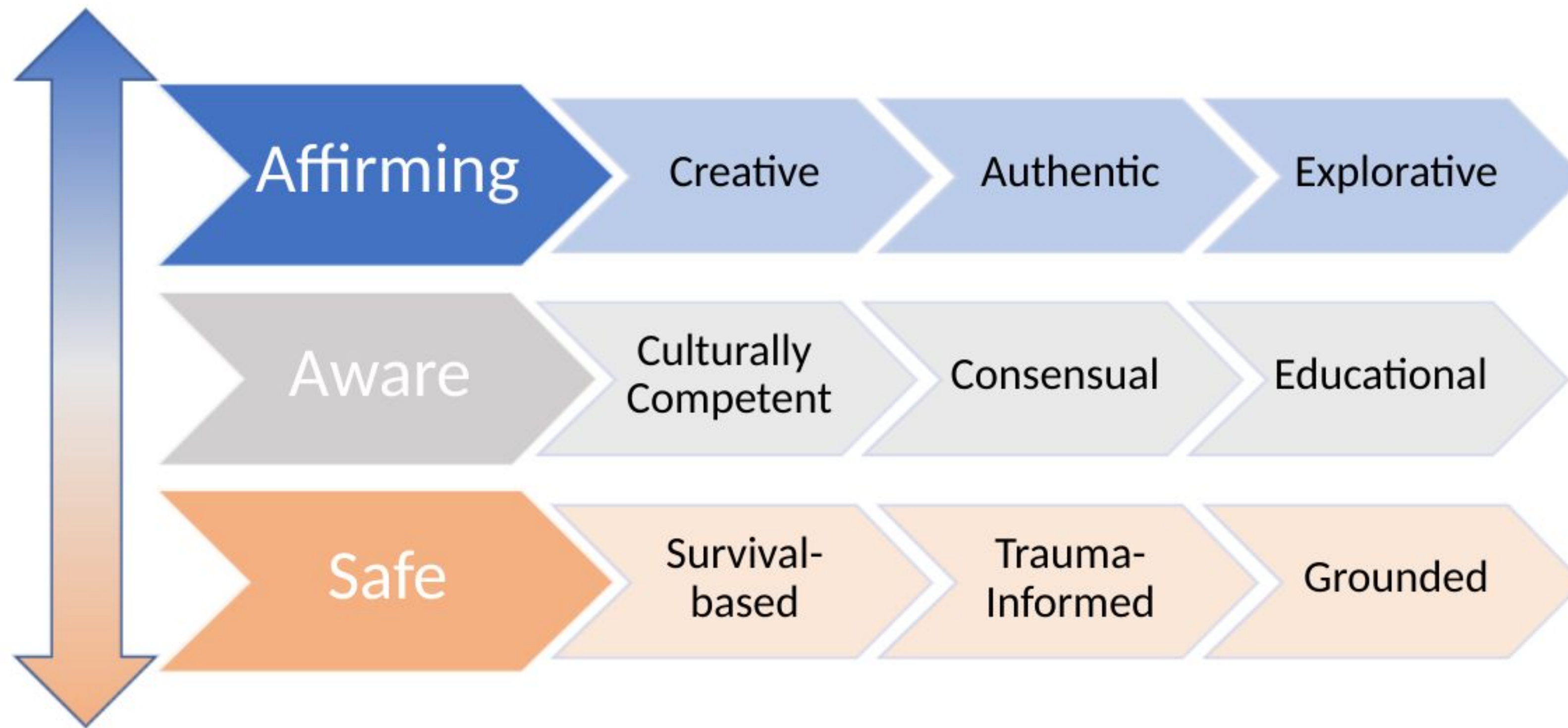
Care

We can offer a different model, one that is patient-centered, trauma informed, and holistic in approach leading to high patient retention and satisfaction

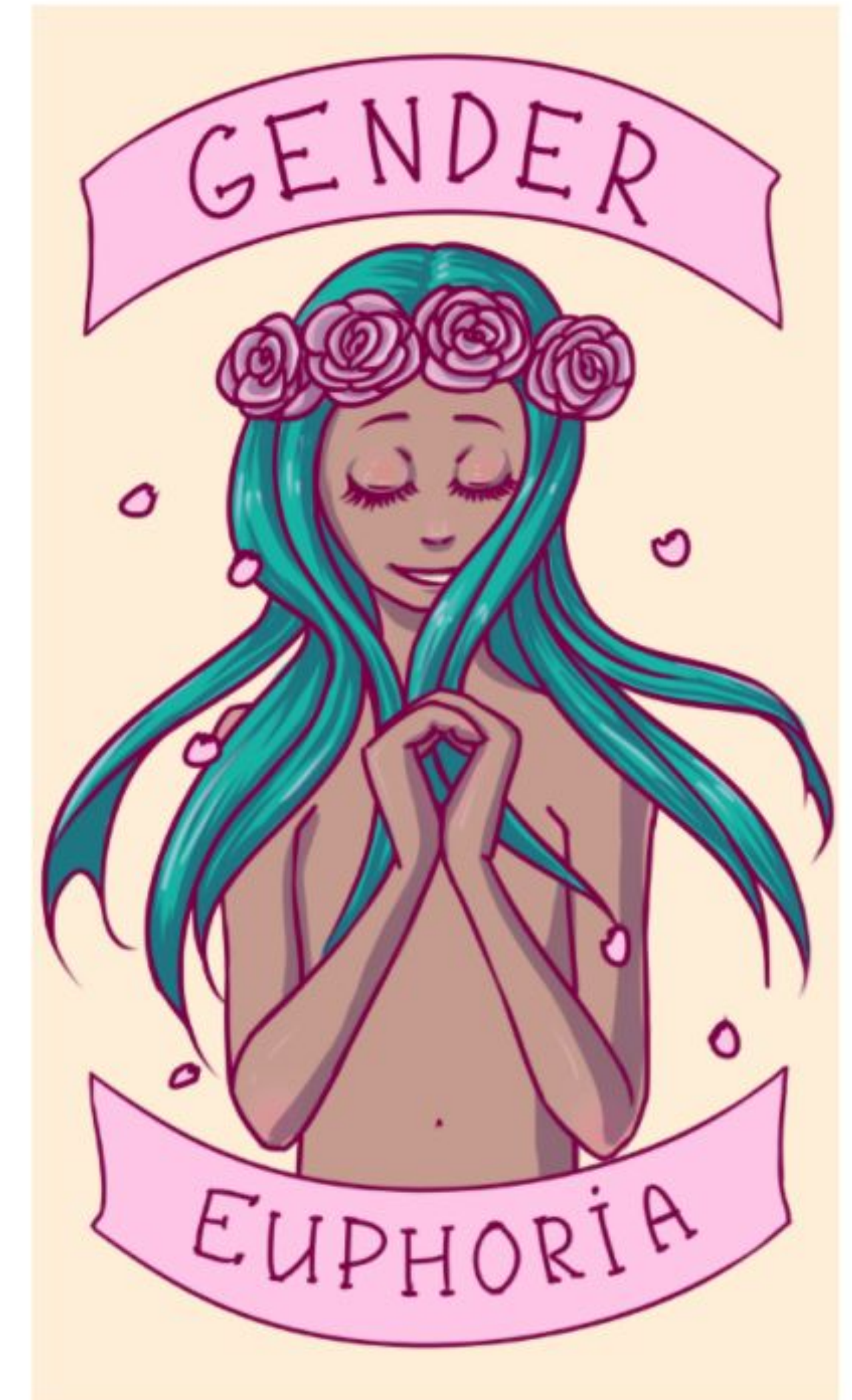
Access

Direct access to affirming care can be life-saving for all patients and change the relationship to healthcare

Affirmation is an interpersonal process; the floor is a safe space, the ceiling is the ability for the individual to be authentic and curious



The patient interaction becomes a space for co-creation and recognition of bias – this relationship is the platform for healing and growth.





Moving Forward and Showing Up

Dispelling Misconceptions: Transgender People Do Not Enjoy Special Privileges

Discrimination: Nearly half including 68% of transgender people of color.

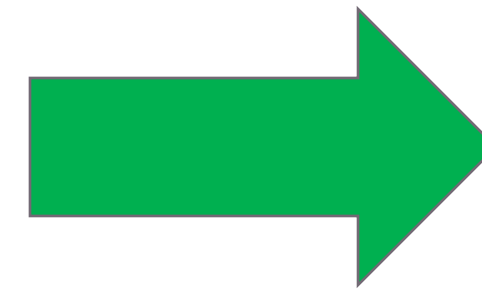
Postponing/Avoiding Care: More than half, including 60% of transgender respondents of color.

Insurance Denials: 46%, including 56% of transgender respondents of color.



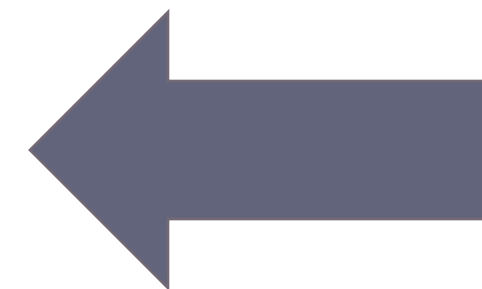
Dispelling Misconceptions: Suicide Attempts are Not Intrinsic to Being Trans

40% of transgender persons will attempt suicide



82% less likely with support

13x more likely with unsupportive families



40% of transgender persons will attempt suicide

These are those who live to report suicidality.

Dispelling More Misconceptions

1. **Fact:** Puberty is irreversible – the choice to do nothing is a permanent one.
 - a. Blockers are not just about pause, but preventing unwanted irreversible choices.

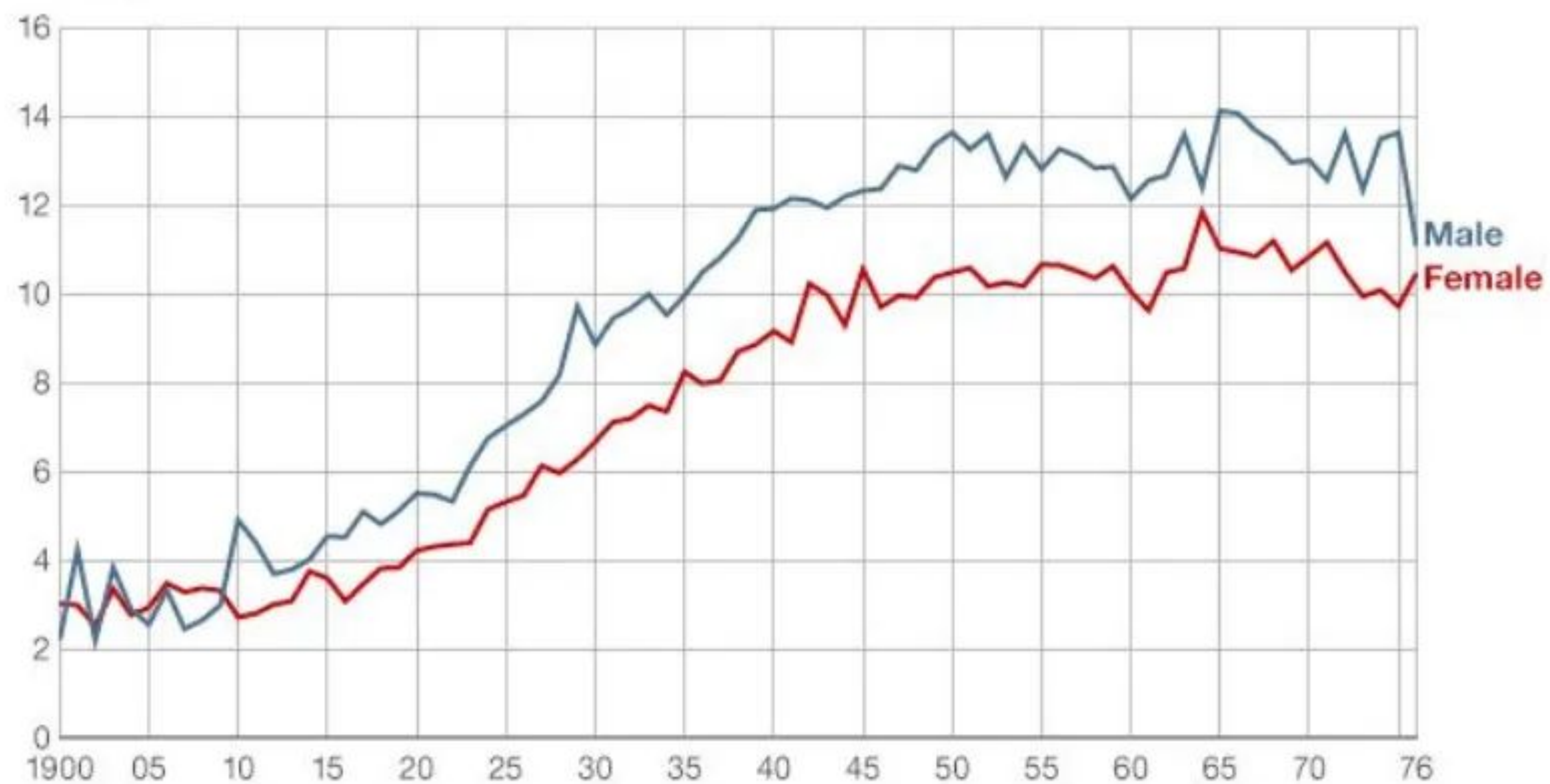
2. **Fact:** This is an assessment, not a conveyor belt - including multiple mental health providers in pediatric care and parents at every stage before any decision is made.
 - a. Assessment and treatment planning according to the expert standards of care.

3. **Fact:** No two transitions are exactly alike. Transition is a very individualized, age-appropriate process that is a long-term partnership between providers, their patients, and the patient's parents.
 - a. One commonality: The rate of regret is incredibly low, lower than knee replacements.

A Changing Landscape

- 8/10 Americans support nondiscrimination
- 2/3rds of Americans oppose bills limiting trans rights
- Fox News poll (2023) 83% believe trans children are wrongly targeted by political attacks
- Five percent of youth now identify as gender-diverse, 20% of Gen Z identify as LGBTQ+
- An overwhelming majority believes the government should not intervene in medical decisions regarding gender-affirming care for transgender youth, provided parents are involved in those decisions (2024 Mason Dixon Polling & Strategy poll among registered voters in South Carolina)

Professional Organizations Support Gender-Affirming Care

Professional associations have clear policies in support of advocacy and activism, and many explicitly require advocacy as an ethical principle for patient advocacy.

Emphasize Shared Values

- Common values: liberty, freedom, and the pursuit of happiness
- Parental rights, keep government bans out of family decisions
- Emphasize shared experience
- Illustrate concrete harms
- Avoid reinforcing negative beliefs
