ADMISSION

Applicants must meet the admission standards of the Graduate School and be accepted by the School of Social Work. Persons holding a Master of Social Work (MSW) degree or actively enrolled in the advanced portion of an MSW program are eligible. Nine of the fourteen graduate credits required by the certificate may be applied toward the MSW degree for students concurrently enrolled in the degree and certificate programs. CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS

Candidates for the certificate must hold a Master degree, achieve a minimum honor point average of 3.0 and complete 14 credits of designated graduate courses. These courses include offerings in social work family theory, social work family practice and social work ethics. Students must earn the certificate and complete required course work within three years.
