Health Disparities & Substance Use

This course introduces health disparity frameworks and provides an overview of the unique problems and needs of diverse populations who misuse alcohol, tobacco and other drugs.

Content will focus on the application of culturally sensitive intervention and prevention strategies. Each week will examine specific topics or identity categories (e.g. Black and African Americans, First Nation or Native Americans, Women, adolescents, etc.) that are the focus of the readings/discussion. Many of these topics/identity categories overlap and will be addressed multiple times throughout the semester.
