## **Clinical Scholarship Track**

This track prepares graduates for important careers in clinical social work teaching, scholarship, and research, as well as for leadership positions in the greater clinical social work community. *This track is not a separate program, nor is it a DSW. It is part of the existing doctoral program.* 

### Dual-title in Social Work and Gerontology

This program addresses the critical need for social work faculty and researchers trained in geriatrics who can promote evidence-based practices and serve as role models for future generations of social workers specializing in the field.

### Dual-title in Social Work and Infant Mental Health
