
ALANDMARK INVESTMENT

Established in 1946, Wayne State's business school was renamed in 2015 in recognition of a \$40 million gift from Mike and Marian Ilitch. Thanks to this lead investment, the school moved to a new, state-of-the-art building in the heart of The District Detroit in 2018, and academic programming and collaboration with the region's business community are expanding.

The llitches' gift is the largest in the history of the university and ranks as one of the largest gifts ever to name a public business school in the United States.

ACCELERATED DEGREE PROGRAMS

High-achieving upperclassman can take advantage of our Accelerated Graduate Enrollment (AGRADE) program, which allows them to take — and double count — M.B.A. classes during their junior and senior years.

Our M.B.A. program offers an accelerated 11-week/4-week format and flexible full-time and part-time options to allow students to complete their degrees in less time. A GMAT waiver is available to qualified applicants.

CAMPUS OPTIONS

llitch School students can take courses at our state-of-the-art home in the heart of Detroit or at any one of several satellite campuses across Southeast Michigan. Online classes are also available.

AFFORDABLE AND ACCESSIBLE

In addition to Wayne State's annual \$350 million in student support, the llitch School provides \$500,000 in merit- and need-based scholarships earmarked just for business students.

BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

Lectures, coursework, exams — what happens in the classroom is just the beginning of a Wayne State business education. We offer a wide variety of hands-on learning experiences, including co-ops and internships, service-learning projects, and study abroad trips to Europe, Asia and South America.

A CULTURE OF MENTORSHIP

Our dedicated staff serves students before they set foot on campus, through graduation, and as alumni throughout their careers. From admission questions and efficient academic plans to career coaching and job placement, the llitch School's professional advisors are here to help.

Multiple mentorship programs — including the Corporate Mentor Program and PwC MPREP Scholars Program — are designed to encourage, develop and graduate first-generation college students and underrepresented minorities. Additional extracurricular programs help students develop networking, presentation and other "soft" skills that are vital for a successful career in business.
