APPLICATION PROCEDURES

To be considered for any need-based scholarship(s) you must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Website address is (http://www.fafsa.gov/).

Submit the School of Social Work Application for Private Scholarship and Financial Aid according to the deadlines on the application. Only complete applications will be considered for SSW financial aid and/or scholarships. All applications must include a complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Student Aid Report (SAR). For Canadian students they must submit an Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP). All Students must submit confirmation of financial support, supporting tax documentation and proof of all income earned. Earned income includes income earned through employment, income presented as gifts, and income from a spouse/partner, if applicable. Incomplete, missing or inaccurate information will result in disqualification of an application for SSW financial aid and/of scholarships. Attach a copy of your individual and spouse/partner's W-2 forms and all other proof of income such as 1099 form, Supplemental Income Confirmation etc, along with a copy of your updated resume.

Note: BSW students <u>must have completed all university general education requirements</u> to apply for the School of Social Work based scholarships awards.

Your receipt of any award is contingent upon your agreement that the School will inform the donor of the scholarship, your name and selected general information regarding your qualifications for this award. You will be asked to write a note to the donor and attend events (specifically the Annual Scholarship Reception) honoring donors and recipients. Failure to do so will result in the rescinding of the scholarship award.
